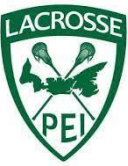

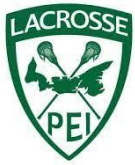

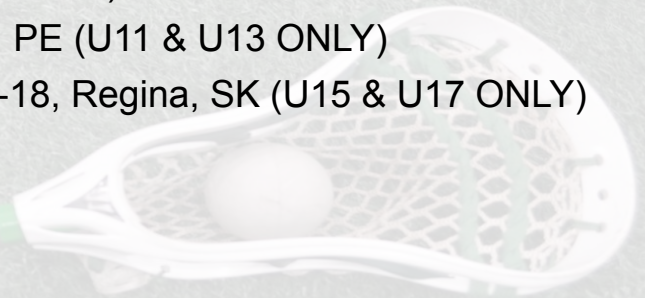
- On top of regular Season Commitments (April/May/June)

- Min 2 Floor times weekly in July/August

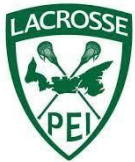
Tournaments

Provincial Season Overview - **Cost (Team Fees)** - Ryan

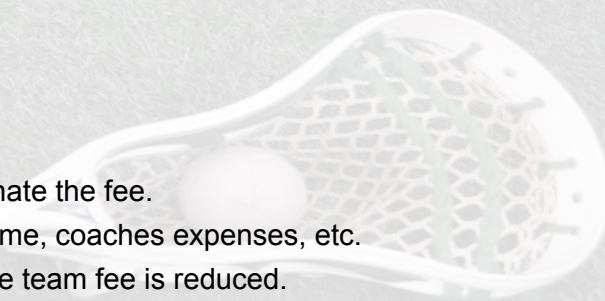
- Costs estimates based on last years team and 2024 plan
- Players may fundraise, obtain sponsors and/or parents opt out and pay for player fees
- Players must also participate in Team Fundraisers.
- Team budgets will be managed by team managers/coaches independent of other teams
- LPEI will supply jerseys to ALL teams for regional tourneys that must be returned
- U15 & U17 will have custom player jerseys for nationals

U11 - U13

- Expected to be \$200-\$300 per player
- Can easily be reduced through sponsorship or fundraising

U15 - U17

- In 2024 the team fee to attend nationals was \$1000 per player.
- Many players fundraised and obtained sponsorship to reduce or eliminate the fee.
- Fee's include mandatory Team Helmets, uniforms, bags, shirts, floor time, coaches expenses, etc.
- If players already own the mandatory Team helmets/bags/uniforms, the team fee is reduced.



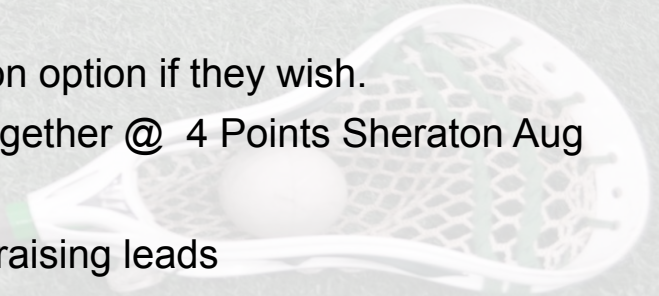


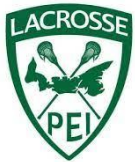

Provincial Season Overview - **Cost (Logistics)** - Ryan

- Travel costs are the responsibility of parents. These are all variable. Car, Bridge, Flights.
- Food costs are the responsibility of parents, but teams may build team meals into budgets.
- Hotels in NS, NB and SK, have already been booked for ALL teams
- All 5 provincial teams are NOT booked at the same hotel for each tourney but we tried our best
- Parents are free to choose another accommodation option if they wish.
- All 3 teams travelling to Regina SK, are booked together @ 4 Points Sheraton Aug 11-18th
- Each team will be looking for a manager and fundraising leads



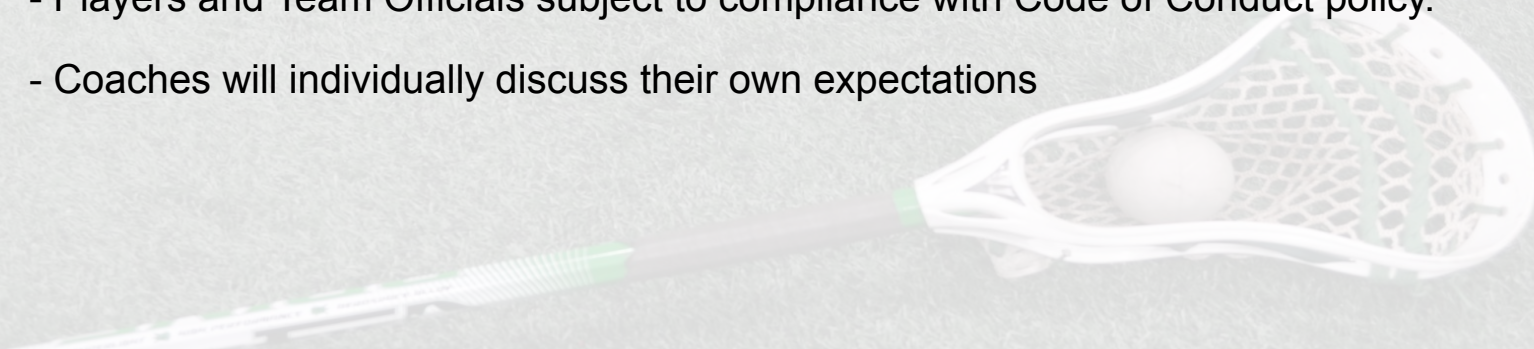

Provincial Season Overview - **Team Selection Policy for Provincial Teams** - Brad

- Policy built in 2024 by LPEI Coaching committee
- 4 ID Sessions and 3 Tryouts - Players must attend 2 of 3 Tryouts.
- U15 & U17 - \$60 - regardless of the # of sessions attended
 - Regular Season Requirement - 50% of practices and 50% of games.
- U11 & U13 - Dates and times TBD. - we are working on booking venues
- Players and Team Officials subject to compliance with Code of Conduct policy.
- Coaches will individually discuss their own expectations

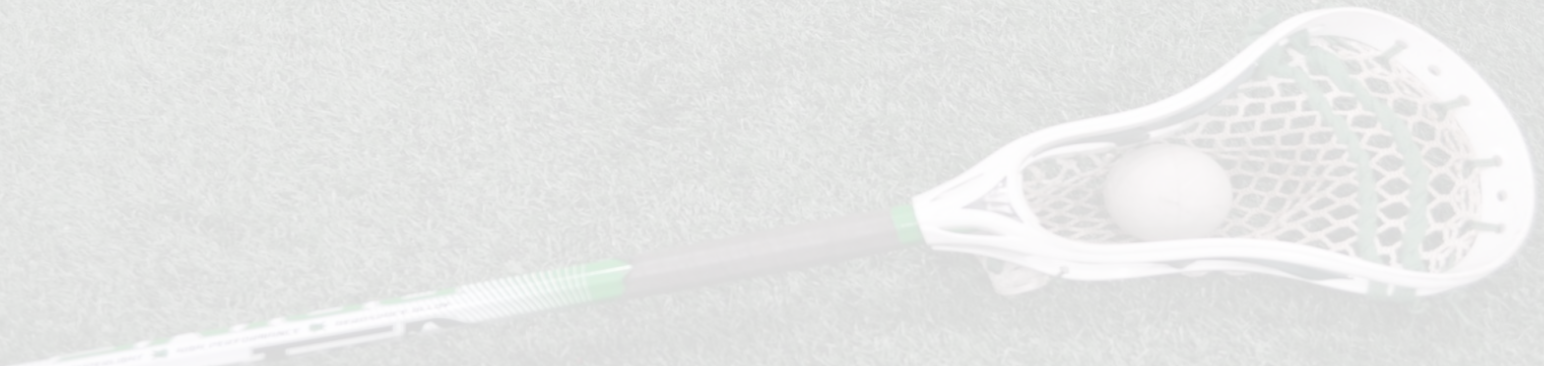

Technical Package Details

- Female Competition - 1st Week - Aug. 8 to Aug. 16, 2025
- Male Competition - 2nd Week - Aug. 17 to Aug. 25, 2025

Roster Composition

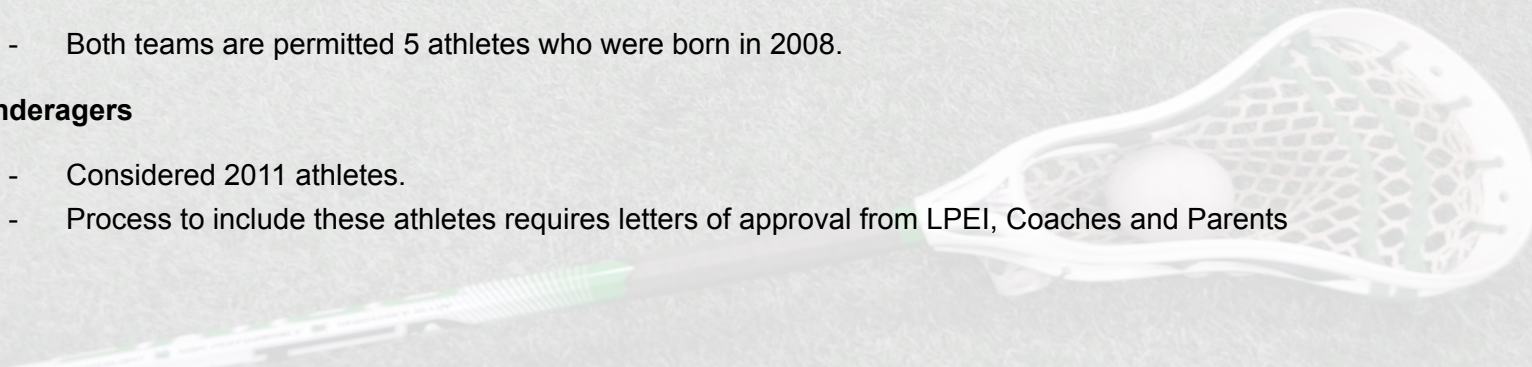
- 18 players - 16 runners and 2 goalies per team. The true age of the tournament is U17 (2009, 2010).

Overagers

- Both teams are permitted 5 athletes who were born in 2008.

Underagers

- Considered 2011 athletes.
- Process to include these athletes requires letters of approval from LPEI, Coaches and Parents





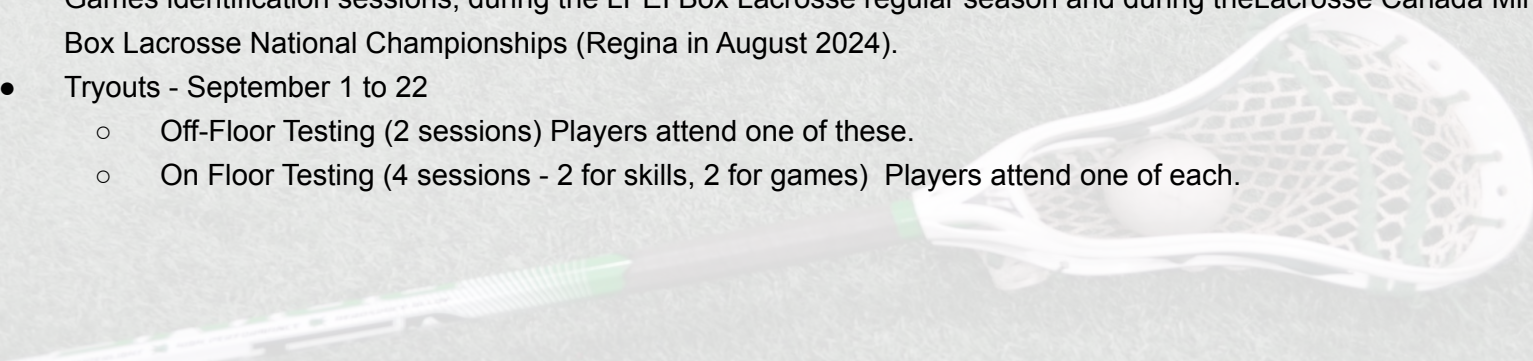

Canada Games Information Session - **Selection Policy** and Logistics - Brad

- Created in 2024 by LPEI Coaching Committee
- Athletes measured on 5 skills:
 1. Stick Skills
 2. Box Lacrosse Intelligence
 3. Game Play
 4. Physical and Athletic Abilities
 5. Coach-ability, Effort, Attitude, Commitment and Team Dynamics
- Sign up by Aug. 15.
- Assessment Time period – Present to August 31 st : Ongoing players assessments can and may occur at Canada Games identification sessions, during the LPEI Box Lacrosse regular season and during the Lacrosse Canada Minor Box Lacrosse National Championships (Regina in August 2024).
- Tryouts - September 1 to 22
 - Off-Floor Testing (2 sessions) Players attend one of these.
 - On Floor Testing (4 sessions - 2 for skills, 2 for games) Players attend one of each.

Canada Games Information Session - **Logistics and Costs** - Brad

- Athletes are completely taken care of in St. John's.
- Parent travel, accommodations and food are their own responsibility.
- Team excursions could include parents, for example whale watching.
- Tickets to games offered through Team PEI, incl. Opening and Closing Ceremonies.
- Lacrosse PEI clothing will be offered.

Budget for a Canada Games Team

- Very similar to U17 Budget.
 - Uniforms, training facilities, preparation tournaments, coaches expenses, fitness training.

Possible Schedule (October - April)

- 2 on-floor practices
- 2 fitness practices
- Up to 6 hours

Possible Schedule (April - August)

- The same, regular season, preparation tournaments, weekend games, etc...



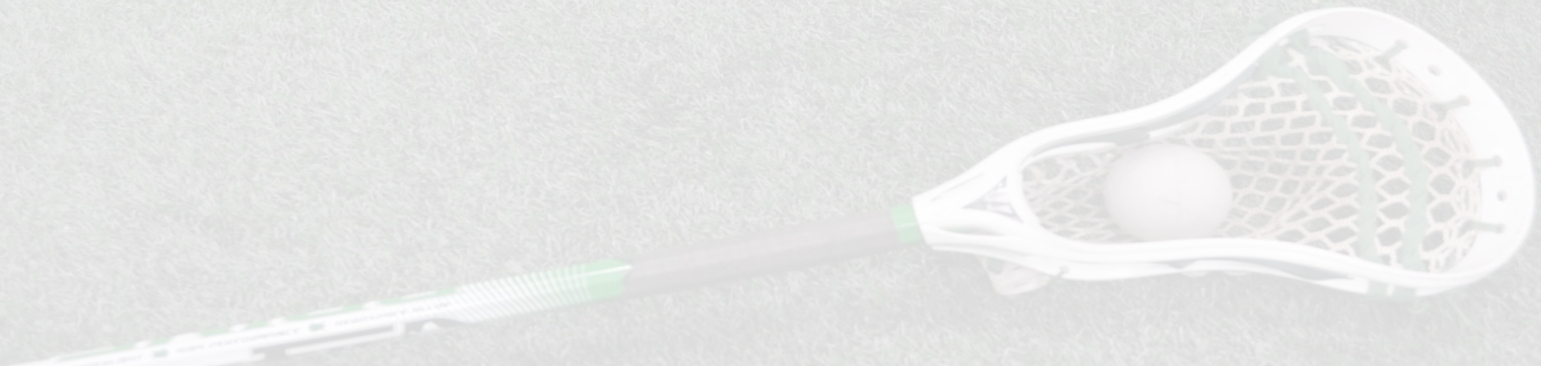


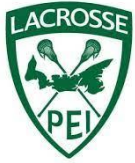
